

Organic Produce Boxes

Warrah Farm Shop delivers fresh seasonal produce boxes to various collection hubs around Sydney, including the Lower North Shore, Eastern Suburbs and the Blue Mountains. It is a simple and convenient way to have fresh organic produce delivered locally to you. Warrah supplements what is grown on Warrah's certified Biodynamic Farm with fresh produce grown by other certified organic producers.

Seasonal Box Options

There are five seasonal produce boxes available:

- Small fruit box - \$20
- Small vegetables box - \$35
- Small fruit AND vegetables box - \$35
- Medium fruit AND vegetables box - \$50
- Large fruit AND vegetables box - \$70

Boxes contain seasonal produce which may vary weekly. We select popular every day fruit and vegetables of high quality. Boxes can be added to by selecting specific fruit and vegetables and other items (for example eggs, honey, nuts and bread). Customers are provided with order lists for these extras which are regularly updated to reflect seasonal produce and price variations.

How can you order?

1. It's simple! Contact the Warrah Farm Shop Manager (Borja Valls) at bvalls@warrah.org or 0448 881 060 to identify a convenient local Warrah Collection Hub, obtain a Registration Form and Order list.
2. Complete your Registration Form and Order List. Submit via email to the Farm Shop Manager. You will receive a welcome email and further information.
3. Collect your seasonal produce from your Collection Hub.

More Information

1. All orders are recurring unless you inform the Warrah Farm Shop otherwise. You need to inform us if you have any changes to your order by sending through a revised Order List. Likewise, if you have ordered extra items these will also be recurring unless you cancel them or send through a revised Order List.
2. The day and time that the produce is delivered to your Collection Hub is set by the Warrah Farm Shop and the Collection Hub Coordinator.

3. Payment is by Direct Debit. Customers are required to complete a Direct Debit Form. Payments will be charged 3-4 days after receiving the order.
4. If you want to cancel your order for a specific week or period, you are required to contact the Warrah Farm Shop one week before the day that your produce is delivered to your specific Collection Hub.
5. Produce boxes clearly display the contact names and details of customers.
6. Your Collection Hub Coordinator is your first point of contact if you are delayed in collecting your produce.
7. When you collect your seasonal produce you are required to bring reusable bags to carry your items. Boxes/crates used to transport produce to the Collection Hub are to be left behind for reuse and are the property of the Warrah Farm Shop.
