

Organic Food Co-op Boxes

Warrah Biodynamic Farm in Sydney's North-West, grows a wide range of certified biodynamic and organic seasonal produce, picked daily for sale to the public in the Warrah Farm Shop and for supplying co-op boxes to collection points around Sydney. Warrah-grown produce is supplemented by fresh produce and other goods supplied by certified organic producers. We endeavour to provide products that are from boutique goods producers.

Seasonal Box Options

There are five co-op box options available:

- Small fruit box - \$20
- Small vegetables box - \$40
- Small fruit AND vegetables box - \$40
- Medium fruit AND vegetables box - \$58
- Large fruit AND vegetables box - \$78

Boxes contain seasonal produce, which may vary weekly. We select popular everyday fruit and vegetables of high quality. Boxes can be added to by selecting specific fruit and vegetables and other items (for example eggs, honey, nuts and bread). Customers are provided with order lists for these extras, which are regularly updated to reflect seasonal produce and price variations.

How can you order?

1. It's simple! Contact the team at wholesome@warrahfarmshop.org.au to identify a convenient local Warrah Co-op Collection point, obtain a direct debit form and order list.
2. Complete and return your form and order via email.
3. Collect your seasonal produce from the co-op collection point.

More Information

1. All orders (both standard boxes and extra items selected on the list) are recurring, unless you notify us. You need to inform us if you have any changes to your order by sending through a revised order list.
2. The day and time that the produce is delivered is set by the Warrah Farm Shop and the Co-op Coordinator.
3. Payment is by Direct Debit. Customers are required to complete a Direct Debit Form. Payments will be charged approximately 3-4 days **after** receiving the produce.
4. If you want to cancel your order for a specific week or period, you are required to send an email to wholesome@warrahfarmshop.org.au one week before the day that your produce is to be delivered.

5. Co-op boxes clearly display the names of customers. Please ensure you take the correct produce as boxes are not all the same.
6. Your Co-op Coordinator is your first point of contact if you are delayed in collecting your produce.
7. Depending on your host you may be required to bring your own reusable bags when collecting your produce so that boxes can be reused. If your co-op is located at a school, do not leave boxes behind.
